THE CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) (No. 3) BILL, 2020

MEMORANDUM

1. Object of the Bill

The object of the Bill is to amend the Third Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda in accordance with articles 259 and 262 of the Constitution to include the Maragoli who settled in Uganda in the 19th Century as one of Uganda's indigenous communities as at 1st February, 1926.

2. Provisions of the Bill

The Bill seeks to amend the Third Schedule to the Constitution to provide for the Maragoli as one of Uganda's indigenous communities as at 1st February, 1926.

3. Procedure for amendment of the Third Schedule to the Constitution

The procedure for amending the Third Schedule to the Constitution is by Parliament through a bill for an Act of Parliament supported at the second and third readings by the votes of not less than two-thirds of all members of Parliament as provided for by article 262 of the Constitution.

An Act to amend the Third Schedule to the Constitution in accordance with articles 259 and 262 of the Constitution to provide for the Maragoli as one of Uganda's indigenous communities as at 1st February, 1926.

BE IT ENACTED by Parliament as follows:

Amendment of the Third Schedule to the Constitution.

The Third Schedule to the Constitution is amended by inserting immediately after paragraph 53, the following—

"53A. Maragoli"
