**WHEREAS** the Parliament of Uganda received with deep sorrow the sad news of the demise of Mr. Emmanuel Tumusiime Mutebile, which occurred on Sunday, 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2022;

**AWARE THAT** Mr Emmanuel Tumusiime Mutebile has had a distinguished career, serving in various capacities both in the public service of Uganda, the private sector and on the international arena;


**RECOGNISING THAT** Mr. Emmanuel Tumusiime Mutebile has held several key positions of responsibility including-

- (a) Deputy Principal Private Secretary to the President, State House, Entebbe, June 1979 to 1980;
- (b) Acting Under Secretary, Ministry of Planning & Economic Development, 1981;



- (c) Chief Government Planning Economist, Ministry of Planning and Economic Development, 1982;
- (d) Permanent Secretary in charge of Economic Affairs, Office of the Prime Minister, from September 1985 to May 1986;
- (e) Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Planning & Economic Development from May 1986 to 1992;
- (f) Chairman, Agricultural Policy Committee and also Chairman of the Steering committee for drawing up the Agricultural Modernization Plan, 1986-1996;
- (g) Permanent Secretary/Secretary to the Treasury, Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning, April 1992 to May 1998;
- (h) Consultant for the International Monetary Fund in Washington D.C. as a member of the External Review Group on the Fiscal Affairs Department of the IMF, August 2000;
- (i) Chairman of the Association of African Central Banks from August 2003 to August 2004;
- (j) Chairperson of the Executive Board of the African Capacity Building Foundation, based in Harare, Zimbabwe, from 2003 to 2006; and
- (k) Governor and Chairperson of the Board of Directors of Bank of Uganda, December 2000 to date;

**APPRECIATING THAT** Mr. Emmanuel Tumusiime Mutebile was a diligent leader who immeasurably served Uganda with dedication and patriotism and participated in shaping the destiny of Uganda through modernisation of Uganda's
